OVERVIEW

The South Lakes area is teeming with wildlife from huge spectacular displays, to small and rare delights.

MORNING

Take the car to [RSPB Leighton Moss](#) (or drive to Grange-over-Sands station and take the train to Silverdale) – members can visit the reserve for free (small charge for non-members). There are plenty of paths to explore as well as 6 impressive hides and the sky tower offering panoramic views of the site. You can round off your visit with lunch in their café which is always well stocked with fresh local goodies.

AFTERNOON

On your way back stop off at [Foulshaw Moss](#) nature reserve. If you visit between April and September, you'll be able to spot our local resident osprey pair – but at any time of the year there are interesting walks around this peaceful site, with excellent views of nearby Whitbarrow Scar.



And the wildlife spotting doesn't end there, there's plenty of wildlife to spot from the comfort of your cottage, including deer, badgers, hares, foxes, and a huge variety of birds.

LOCAL TIP

Take a short walk from Leighton Moss to visit Silverdale Moss – it's usually deserted but can be a great spot for starling murmurations.
