OVERVIEW

Naturally the Lake District is famous for its soaring fells, but there are plenty of low-level adventures to be had too.

MORNING

Fell Foot is a National Trust park just a few miles away, nestled at the southern tip of Windermere. There are short walks around the park and adjacent meadow, or take the opportunity to hire a kayak and explore the Lake District from the middle of its longest lake.

Enjoy lunch at the café overlooking the lake, then take a wander around the marina before heading off.

AFTERNOON

Drive up the road opposite Fell Foot to the car park in the woods near to Gummer's How, then from there follow the path up the hill for one of the best views in Cumbria. On a clear day you can see north as far as Skiddaw and Blencathra and to the south you'll be able to spot Blackpool Tower on the horizon.



Once you're done, head back to your cottage and either cosy up in front of the log fire, or enjoy a relaxed evening in the garden.

LOCAL TIP

For a longer walk use your map to explore the paths behind Gummer's How and around Sow How.
