AFTERNOON

If you do manage to drag yourself away then there are a couple of options :

Option 1: If you fancy a 30 minute drive then aim for Sedbergh, well known as England's Book Town, it's crammed with independent books shops and has the glorious Farfield Mill right on the doorstep – and old woollen mill and local craft collective with a fabulous history and a wonderful café.



Option 2: Take a 5 minute drive back into Cartmel village and visit Village Vintage, or check out the old book store nestled in the medieval stone gatehouse.
